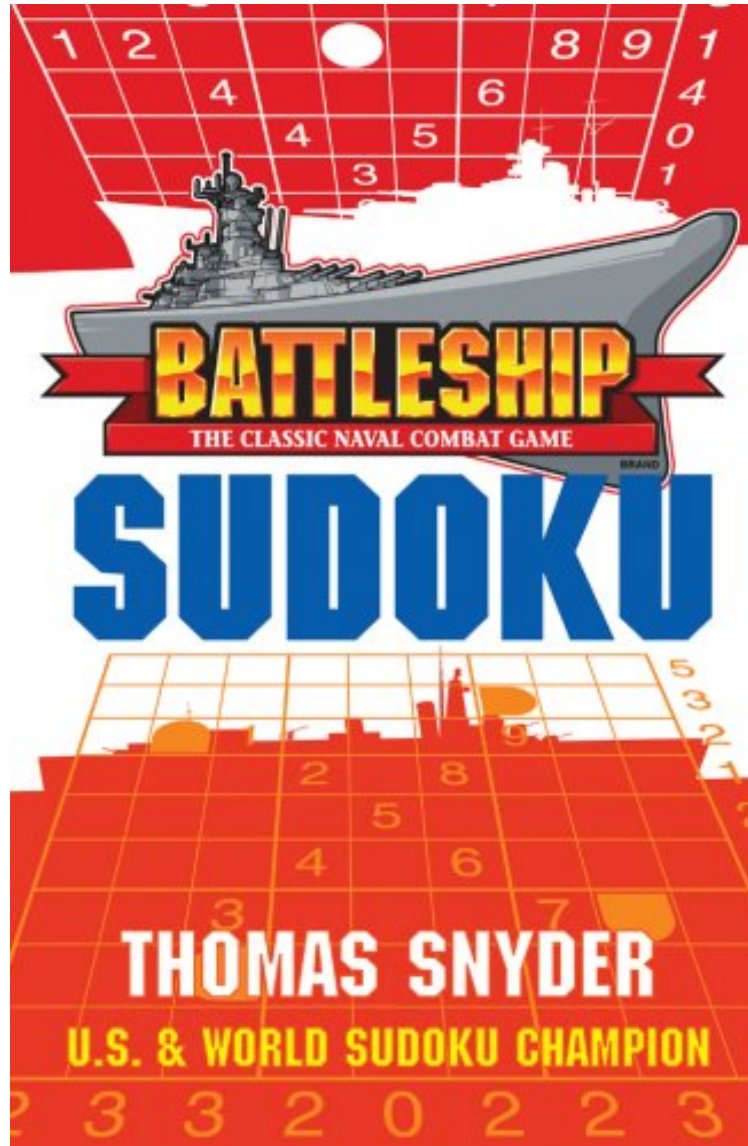

By bobthatsme This book combines Battleship puzzles with Sudoku to create an interesting variation which has more logical constraints than either puzzle alone. The increased constraints might make you think it will be easier, but it also allows the puzzles to give you fewer starting hints and forces you to find more logical paths through which you can eliminate possibilities

in order to get to the one correct solution. This also makes it a more interesting puzzle which all but the most jaded Sudoku puzzler should enjoy. The more difficult they got, the more eager I became to get started on the next one. The book starts with a small section of easy to moderate puzzles for each of the two types along with a good discussion on how to go about solving them. This is a sufficient introduction if you haven't solved Battleship puzzles before, but I wouldn't recommend this book for a novice Sudoku puzzler. These sections are followed by 150 Battleship Sudoku puzzles. They start at a moderate level and slowly work their way up to difficult, with a few truly challenging ones thrown in near the very end. I was using a pencil from the very beginning, however, because it's just too easy to occasionally make a mistake with these kinds of puzzles. As with all of Snyder's books, these are hand made puzzles. This not only means that you sometimes get interesting layouts, it also means that you'll have to constantly be figuring out new strategies to get the puzzles started. The only flaw is that puzzle number 184 has a typo making it impossible to solve. 4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. Very entertaining variation on two fun games By R. The author does a brilliant job of easing you into the game rules by introducing each aspect of Battleship Sudoku to you one element at a time.
