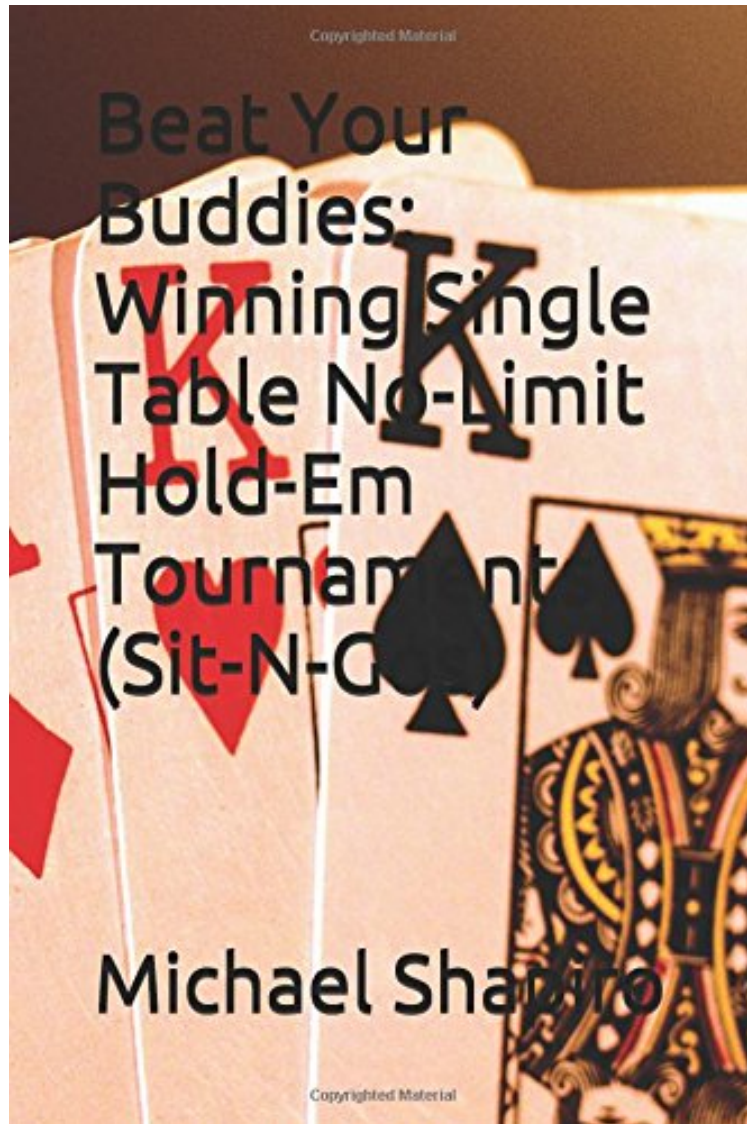

One thing that bothered me a bit though... early on, he was talking about pot odds calculations, and I think he made a recurrent mistake in the calculation. When calculating pot odds, the odds should be: amount in the pot now vs. amount you need to call. However, in his examples, he was combining the pot and call amounts together for the first number, i.e. instead of 6.5 to 1, he would say 9.5 to 1 (when calling a 3\$ bet).
