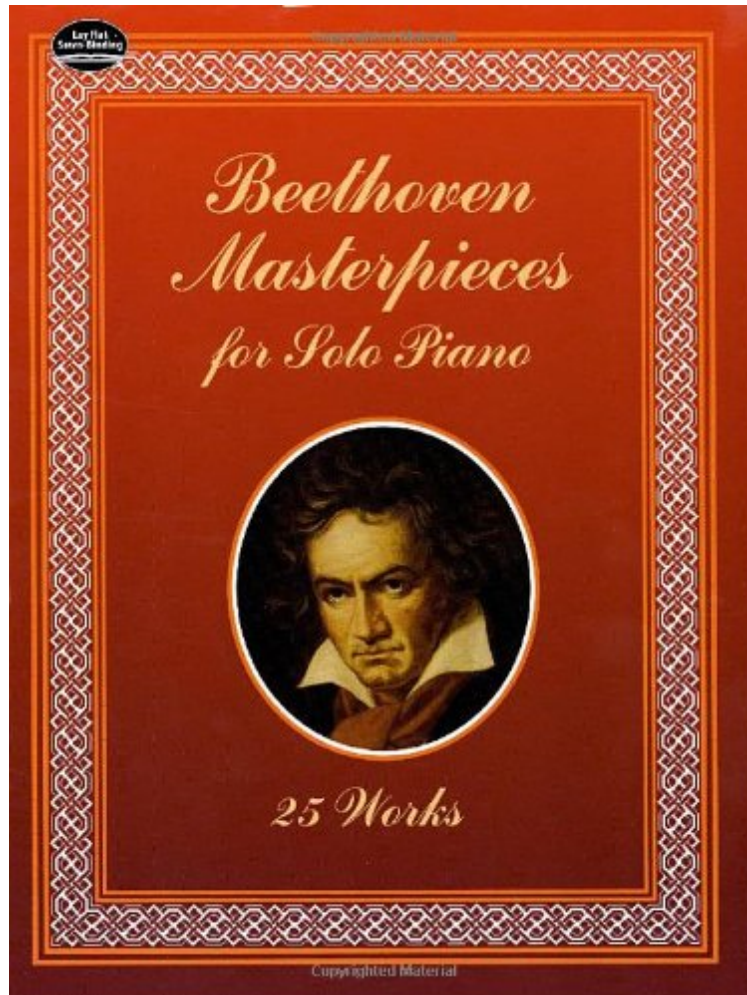

Nothing here is crazy hard, and I'd say that this book tends to chose fun and flashy pieces, BUT many of them have substance. "Tempest", "Moonlight" and "Pathetique" are not very difficult but very fun. This book also includes many of Beethoven's Bagatelles which are

really great for sight reading. Not to mention "Rage over a lost penny" which I read today.
