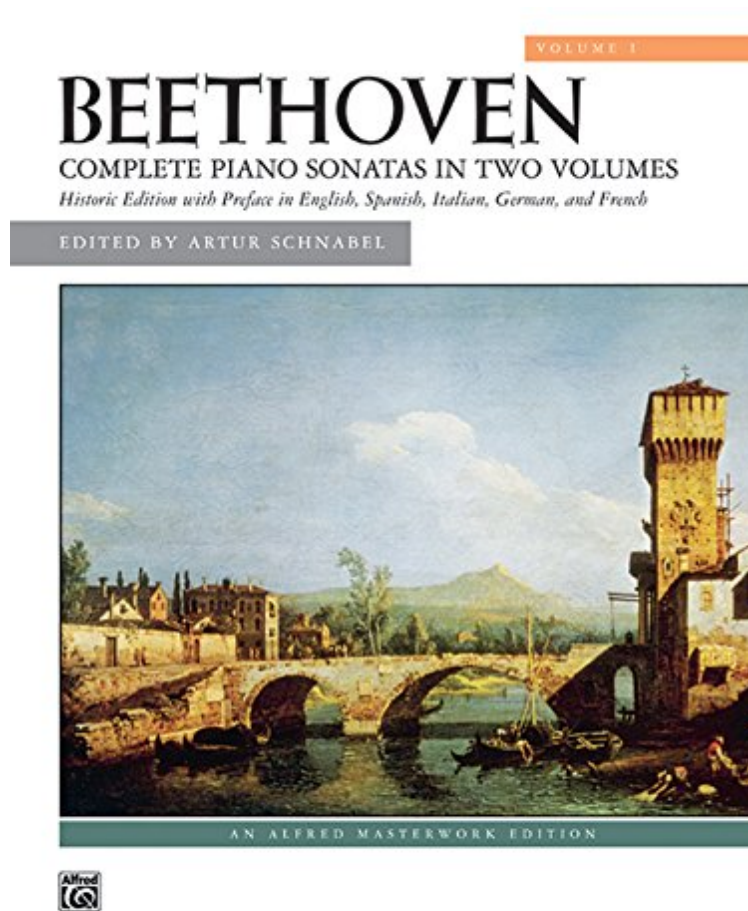

The content of the volume is exemplary, with editing and performance notes by the immortal Artur Schnabel, one of the greatest Beethoven stylists. The printing is sharp, clean and very readable. I purchased only the first volume (Sonatas 1 through 17) for now, but when I need it, I'll be happy to order the second book. didn't have the book, but the vendor they connected me to was prompt and I received the book earlier than expected. After I had the book for about five weeks, I discovered that, during binding, one 16-page signature was included twice and
