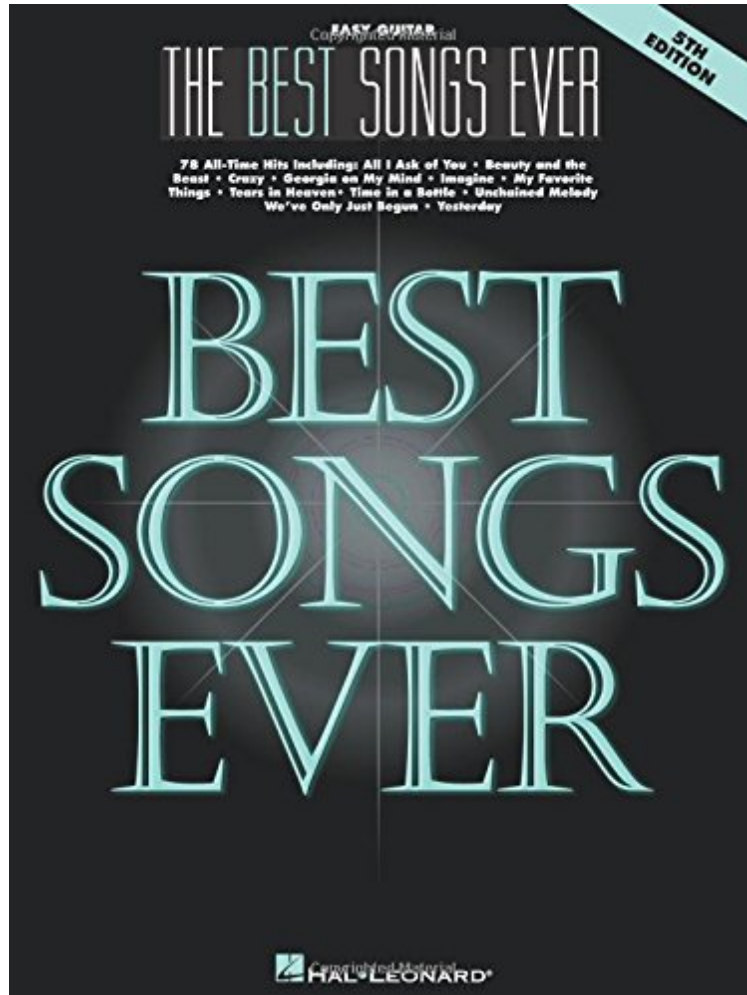

Very readable, size and chords are fine. Not that many songs. I teach and it's a good book of songs. select specific pieces from it and teach students. There are some songs that transcend the ages and this book selects songs more for the ages than just pop songs. Of course, it's better to learn the songs with a teacher. I'm so glad it doesn't have tab, teaching tab should be prohibited:-) The same time one spends learning tab could be spent learning to read music, then the student really has something. While designed to play chords and sing, the melodies are reasonably easy to play for an advanced beginner, maybe simplifying the rhythms, but then the student will be able to sing the pitches. While they have simplified open string chord charts, I teach the songs using
