"Bleak Expectations" is a delightfully witty radio comedy about young master Pip Bin and his ever ongoing battles against his evil ex-guardian Mr. Gently Benevolent. Pip's misadventures across all 24 episodes is a brilliant mashup up of science-fiction, fantasy, murder mystery, even horror genres while poking great fun at the oh-so-proper British literary giant of Charles Dickens, while having good fun with French and American authors as well. Mr. Gently Benevolent is perhaps the second greatest comedic villain of all time [Dr. Smith being the all time greatest] and his plans for ruling the world are simply brilliantly insane. Evil pigeons with flow charts rock! Now, as frequent readers of my reviews know, I deduct points when writers, producers, and actors feel they need to make inaccurate political jibes that are outright lies. So, I'm deducting one star from my review. Sorry Mark Evans and Gareth Edwards, Obamacare is a debacle that has increased health care solutions for most Americans.
