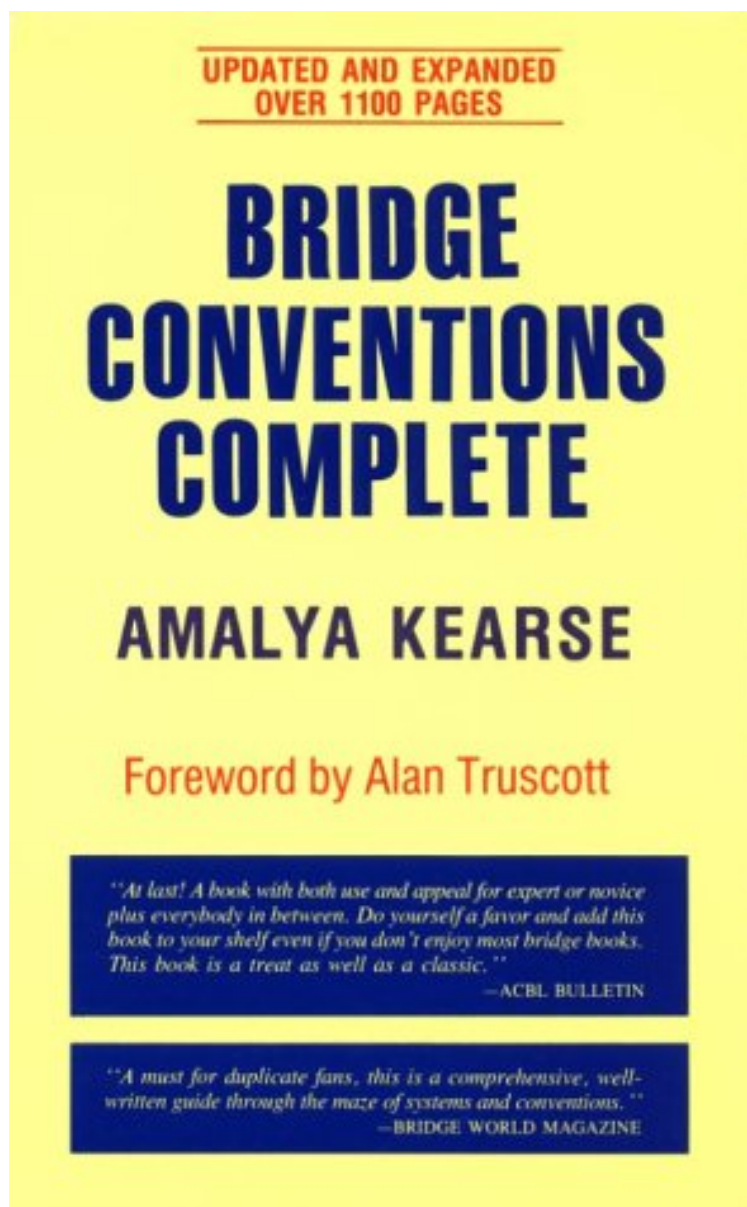

By John Blackwell This book lists all the conventions authorized by the ACBL, describing the intent of the convention, its operation under a variety of circumstances, the pros and cons of using it, and even a few words about the defence to many conventions. It is not intended for the non-serious bridge player. It is intended for partners who have already settled on their basic bidding system, but who wish to review the conventions they use, and decide whether any changes would improve their game. The book is exhaustive rather than brilliant, but if you want a tool to enhance partnership discussion of your bidding methods, this book is hard to beat. 10 of 11 people found the following review helpful.
