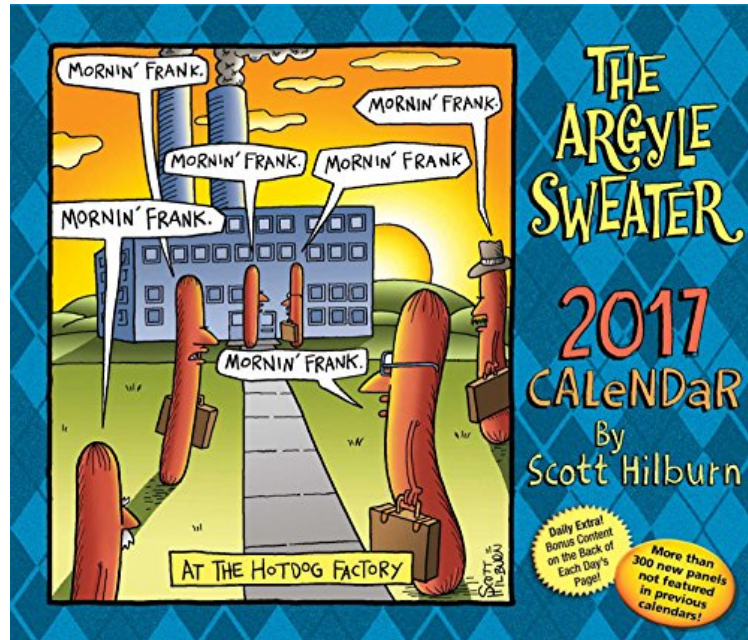

I've also seen a few other reviewers comparing this series to the Far Side. This comic strip is a far cry from the Far Side. I think that since Gary Larson retired, many people (including myself) have been looking for a comic strip to replace it, and many people really want this one to be it. It's not, though... it's just not. They are comparable only in that they are both one-panel comic strips... that's all. Let's put it this way: if the Far Side is Jerry Seinfeld, the Argyle Sweater is Mike "The Situation" Sorrentino. I'm a man who appreciates a bad pun and a good "dad joke"... but these comics make even me groan and roll my eyes. It is now July and I think I can count on one hand the amount of pages that I actually found to be funny.
