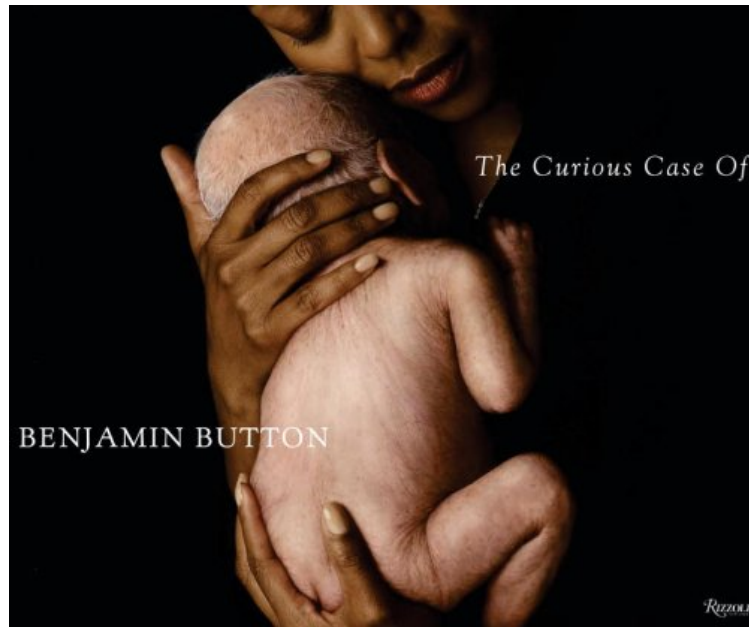

There are pieces throughout the book that show glimpses behind the scenes, but the book plays out more like a long form poem (if that makes much sense). Not heavy reading exactly, but perfect to be pulled off the shelf and flipped through/admired.
