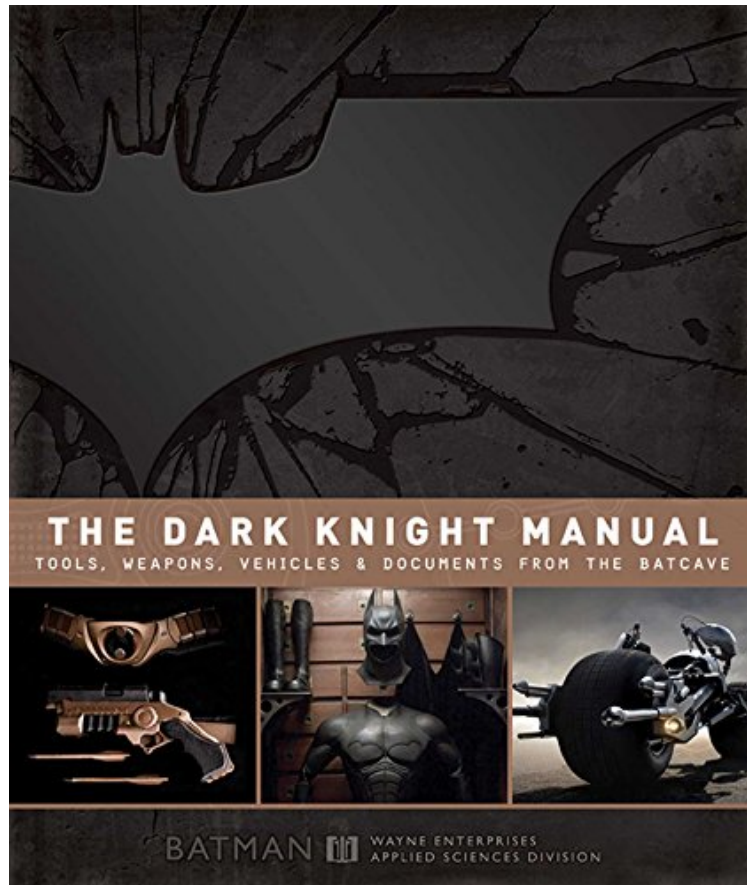

By jbucky1092 Purchased this along with the Iron Man manual, and they both make pretty neat coffee table books to flip through. If you're going to pick up just one of the pair, though, stick to Iron Man. They both have bunch of little inserts, mock sticky notes, dossiers, etc, glued in to the pages that add a neat little touch, and I have no real problem with the maps and schematics in the Dark Knight book, but the presentation of the dossiers is poorly executed and the stickers (which, seriously, we can do without) have the nasty side-effect of pulling ink off of the affronting page! Nix the stickers, and centrally locate all of the dossiers, maps, and schematics in a paper envelope in the back (making sure to not glue them together this time), and this book would be an easy 5 stars.
