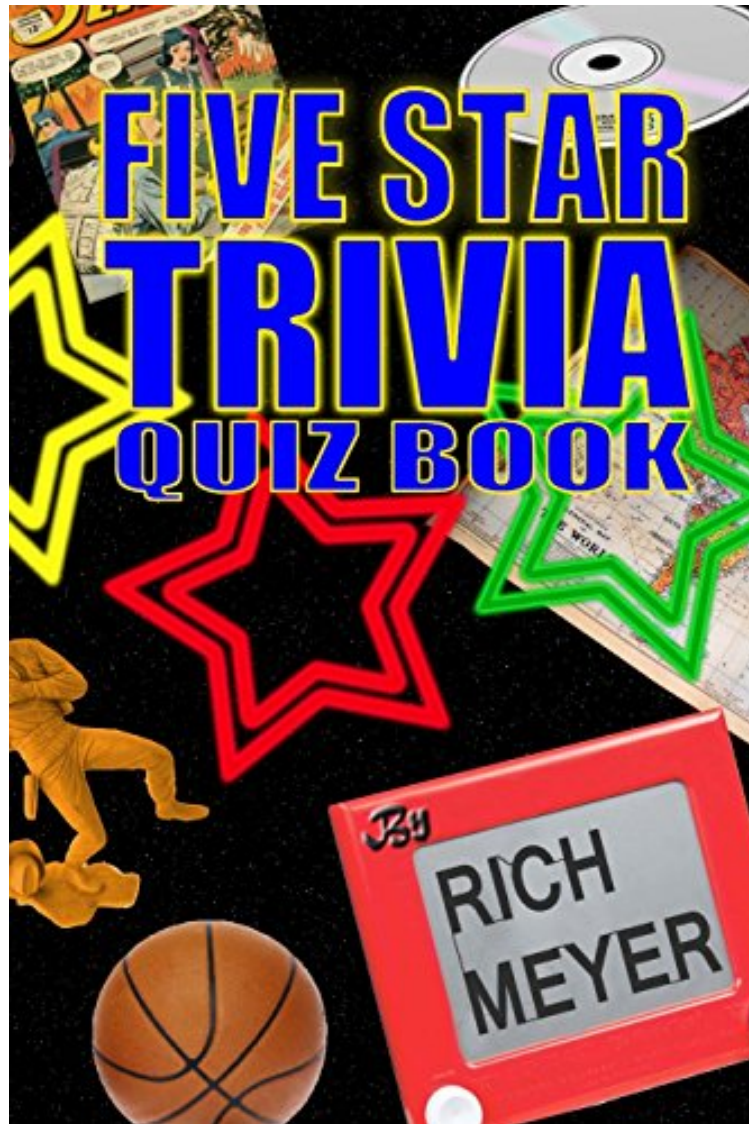

This is a collection of instant recall type trivia questions. By that I mean, these are questions that you either know or you don't, not the kind of questions where you can deduce the answer, usually. Think along the lines of What was the name of Tom Mix's horse. Most of the questions deal with pop media, such as movies, TV, old advertising slogans, etc. The emphasis is more on nostalgia than current pop knowledge. There are a few questions about books and history, but not many-- which is good or bad, depending on your tastes. I really liked the format. A question appears on one page. The answer is on the next page. The next question is on that same page. No having to remember or write down your answers for multiple questions. No flipping back and forth to an answer section. There is a slight problem with words that run together like this. This happens quite a lot, but is not a huge problem.
