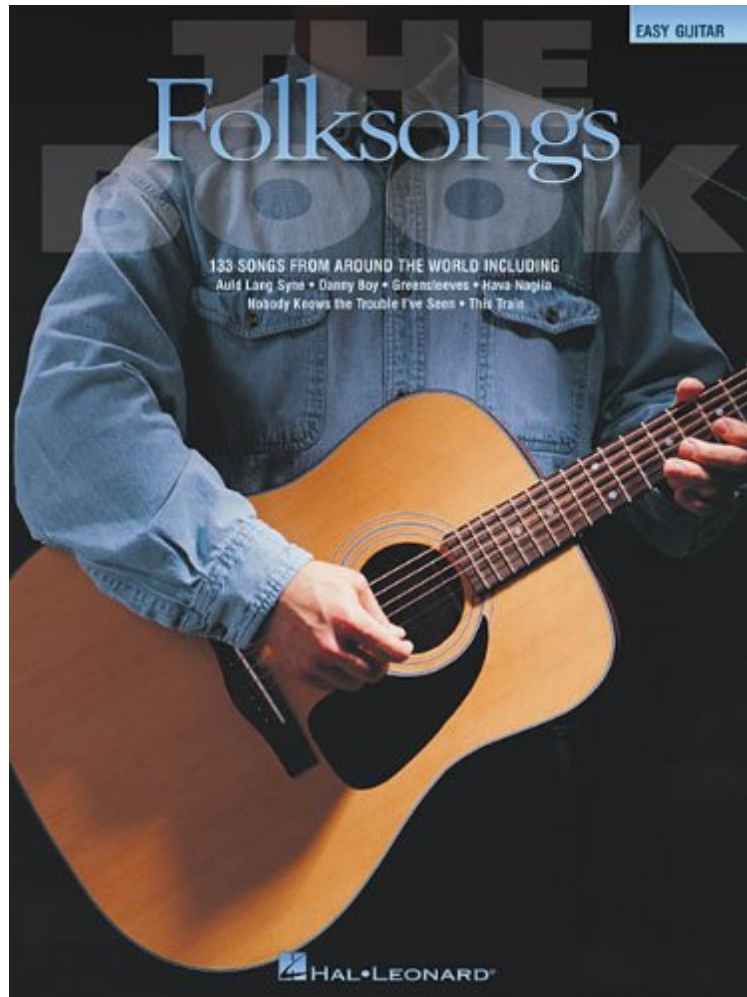

I had not played for many years, and recently started playing again. I needed some music to get me going again and to expand my repertoire, and this book is just what I was looking for. Most of the songs are one to a page. The chord diagrams are shown at the top of the page, and just the names of the chords are shown above each measure. This is fairly common for the guitar music with which I

am familiar. Only the melody is shown, and only the treble clef is shown, which is all most guitarists need. If you can play the major, minor and major seventh chords in the first position, you will be able to play the majority of the songs in this book.
