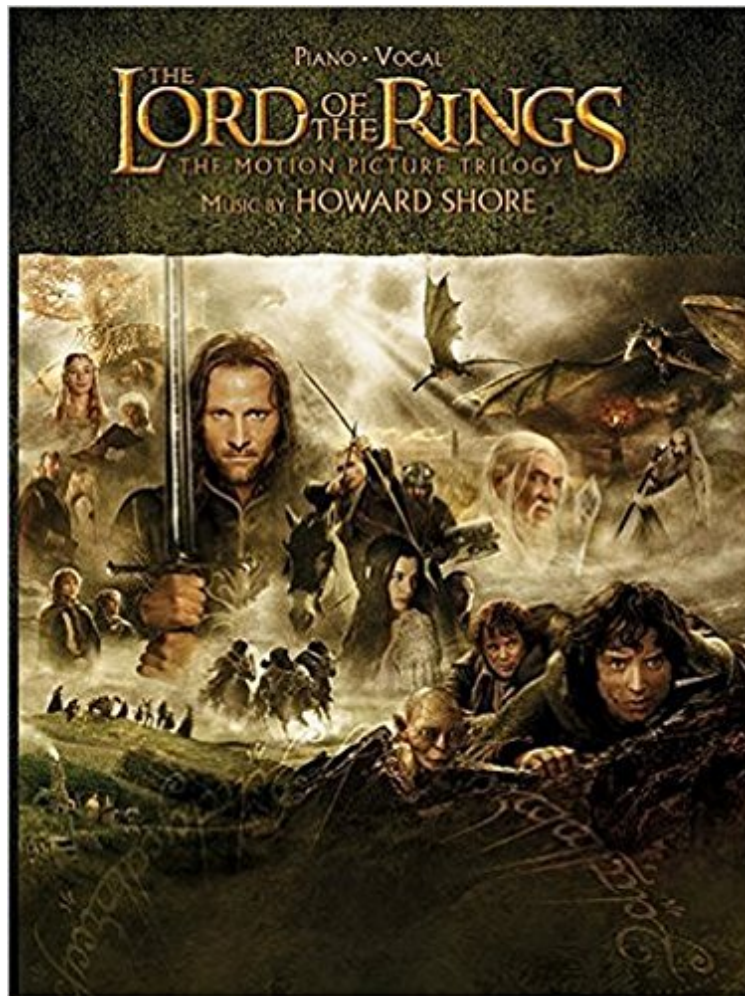

There are some gorgeous parts of the soundtrack that are left out of this, especially one of the main themes that sounds very

grandiose that is played when they are walking through the mountains (from 1:15 in "The Ring Goes South"). What the heck?! Who decides not to include that theme? Example: perhaps the best track in all of the Lord of the Rings trilogy is "The Grey Havens" (in my opinion of course). It is beautiful but isn't in this music book. "Return of the King" in the third movie is another beautiful track that is 10:14 long. However they only have a small portion of the piece: the portion that has vocals. 13 of 13 people found the following review helpful. "Concerning Hobbits" is great, but I was really disappointed in "Into the West." It's just the piano accompaniment with the melody/solo line above it. I would have liked a more "piano solo." You can hardly tell what it is just playing the piano part from this book. I love that song, so I'm going to keep looking for a true 'piano solo' arrangement. And I wish "Grey Havens" was in this book, but it's not. But if you like most of the music from the trilogy, absolutely get this book. It's a great value, and cheaper on than on other sheet music sites, though I think delivery time might have been longer.
